Sponsorship/Vendor Levels:

\$0 – Non-Profit Vendor: recognition on Junior League of Spokane (JLS) website event page and JLS Touch-a-Truck Facebook page, and space for a table/booth at the event

\$50 –For Profit Vendor: recognition on Junior League of Spokane (JLS) website event page and JLS Touch-a-Truck Facebook page, and space for a table/booth at the event



VEHICLE PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

Please complete registration by August 30, 2019

SIGNAGE AND PUBLICITY:

- Promotional materials appropriate for children, such as stickers and giveaways, are strongly encouraged.
- Touch-a-Truck is marketed throughout the Spokane region via print, website, and social media.

PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES:

- 1. The Touch-a-Truck Commitment Form and Certificate of Liability Insurance must be received prior to the event in order to participate.
- 2. Vehicle space assignments will be determined by the Junior League of Spokane based upon the best interests of the event and/or a first-come-first-served basis. Vehicles will be located on the open blacktop.
- 3. Vehicle participants acknowledge that a minimum of one adult representative must be present during the event to supervise the Vehicle(s) between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 21, 2019. Vehicle representative should be able to provide a narrative description of the Vehicle(s)'s specifications and/or services as well as facilitate guided "tours" of the Vehicle(s)'s interior as allowable by the Vehicle's size.
- 4. Vehicle sponsors acknowledge that the nature of the Touch-a-Truck event **involves the interaction of children with vehicle(s) so that the children are able to touch, see and explore the vehicle(s) and learn about the vehicle(s)'s function.** The JLS will take appropriate measures to facilitate a safe event; however, the sponsor remains responsible for the supervision and safety of its vehicle(s). The sponsor shall indemnify, save and hold harmless the Junior League of Spokane and its officers, directors, and volunteers from all liability, damage, loss, claims, costs, demands and actions of any nature whatsoever arising out of the Touch-a-Truck event.
- 5. Vehicle participants will comply with a No Horn policy from 9:00 a.m. 1:00 p.m. Touch-a-Truck is marketed as an inclusive event for all children and attendees; as such, vehicle horns shall be disabled to prevent startling noise. There is a horn hour from 1:00 p.m. 2:00 p.m.
- 6. Vehicle participants/sponsors/vendors must arrive on event day between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. to set-up. Vehicles requiring special accommodations, such as a large turning radius, will be asked to arrive early during event set-up. Vehicles are expected to stay the entire length of the event and may not leave until the event's conclusion at 2:00 p.m. unless otherwise agreed to in advance by the Junior League of Spokane (exceptions for emergency vehicles).

- 7. **Sponsors/vendors may bring a table, banners, signage, decorations, etc. to promote their business.** The Junior League of Spokane shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to vendor property.
- 8. **Sponsor/vendor acknowledges that wireless internet access is not available at the event venue.** Air cards from mobile carriers should work but service is not guaranteed by the Junior League of Spokane.
- 9. Sponsor/vendor grants permission to the Junior League of Spokane to take photographs or record videos of vendor and/or display during the event for the strict purpose of promotion and publicity of the event and/or the Junior League of Spokane.
- 10. Sponsors/vendors and their representatives shall conduct themselves in a manner that is appropriate for a family-oriented event, which includes but is not limited to no smoking, no profanity, and no display of inappropriate content or clothing.
